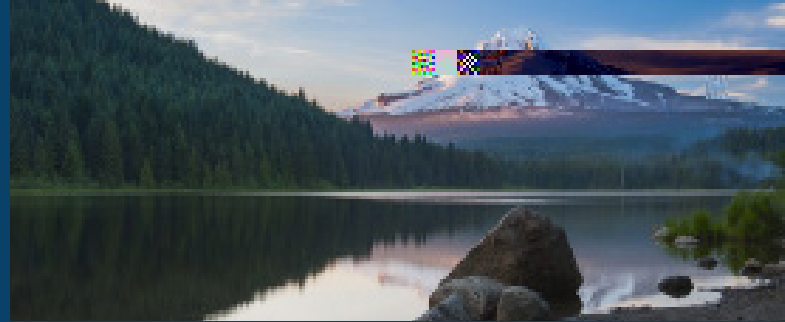

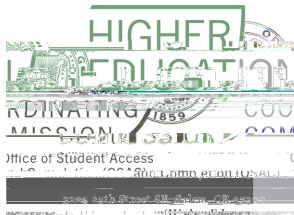

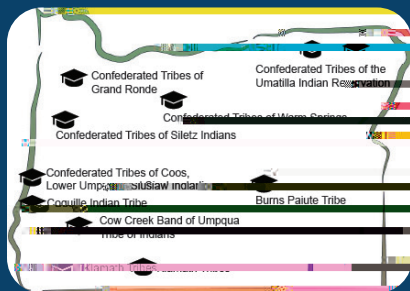
# Eligibility

The Oregon Tribal Student Grant is available to new

- Must be an enrolled member of an Oregon federally recognized tribe
- college or university
- associate, bachelor's or graduate degree

# Application

- Complete a grant
- for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Oregon (ORSAA)
- received by August 1st at 5pm



# Awards

The Oregon Tribal Student Grant is expected to pay for most or all public college-related expenses not cov-

**Associate, Bachelor's, or Graduate degree.** Award amounts will vary depending on where the student

## Undergraduate Public Colleges or

Award will be calculated based on (COA) reduced by the amount of state/federal grants and scholarships

## Undergraduate Private

Award will be calculated based on the average COA at the highest cost public university reduced by the amount of state/federal grants and scholarships

## Undergraduate Other

Award will be calculated based on the average COA at the highest cost public community college reduced by the amount of state/federal grants and scholarships

Award will be calculated based on the average undergraduate amount of state/federal grants and scholarships

Award amounts cannot exceed the student's actual cost of
