**%**Scholarship Applications:

- o OSAC Scholarship opens November 1.
- Look for other scholarships at colleges, through your ASPIRE/College Coordinator, high school counselor, and search platforms like <u>College</u> <u>Board Scholarships</u>, <u>FastWeb</u>, <u>JLV College Counseling</u>, <u>Oregon Goes to</u> <u>College</u> and <u>Scholarships.com</u>.

%College Fit: Finalize your list of colleges (5 - 7 schools with at least one Oregon Community College).

- o Research admissions requirements, costs, scholarships, programs, and student activities.
- o Compare and rank colleges based on your priorities.

%College Entrance Exams: Register and take/re-take SAT/ACT in the fall.

o Talk to your counselor about possible test dates at school.

%Portfolios/Auditions: Finalize materials if required.

- **%**Essay Feedback: Get feedback from teachers, ASPIRE coordinator, mentor, or college advisors.
- %Check Email & College Portals: Regularly check for additional information from colleges and scholarship committees.
