- Oregon Opportunity Grant**
the state's largest, need-based grant program for students attending an Oregon college/university
FAFSA/ORSAA required
- Oregon Promise Grant**
for new high school and GED® test graduates attending community college after graduation
FAFSA/ORSAA required, additional application
- Oregon Student Child Care Grant**
child care funds for parents enrolled in college
FAFSA/ORSAA required, additional application
- Oregon Chafee Education & Training Grant**
for current & former foster youth under age 26
FAFSA required, additional application
- Oregon National Guard State Tuition Assistance**
for current Oregon Army/Air guard members
FAFSA required, additional application
- Oregon Teacher Scholars Grant**
For ethnically diverse and/or heritage speakers of a language other than English in the final two years of an approved Oregon preliminary teacher licensure program.
FAFSA/ORSAA required, additional application
- Oregon Tribal Student Grant**
for students attending an Oregon college/university and who are members of one of Oregon's nine federally recognized tribes
